Initial Case Narrative By C. L. Berry #1088 on 05/12/06 at 1244 hrs.

On 05/12/06 at approximately 0900 hours I was contacted by the assistant principal of Mountain View High School, Susan Slong(ph). Ms. Slong advised me that a student identified as [REDACTED] was at the nurse's office currently under the influence of some type of intoxicant most likely Vodka. She advised that he was so extremely intoxicated that he had to be transported to Northwest Hospital to the Emergency Room.

I responded to the Emergency Room where I contacted [REDACTED]. He advised that he drank appropriately 350 milliliters of Vodka between the hours of 0130 hours and 0900 hours. He advised he drank the alcohol because he was very upset as his father yelled at him. I could see his eyes were very red and he was crying and had a strong odor of intoxicants coming from his body and breath. I was advised by the the nursing staff that he had stolen the alcohol from his father's liquor cabinet.

His parents, Mr. and Mrs. Loughner arrived at the hospital. I explained the situation to them and advised he was under Arrest for Consuming Alcohol. They signed the paper referral and remained at the hospital.
